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Symposium on

Mathematical Foundations of Computer Science MFCS '79

Olomouc, September 3–8, 1979

This international symposium is the eighth in the series of annual MFCS symposia organized alternately in Poland and Czechoslovakia. The MFCS '79 Symposium is being organized by the Mathematical Institute of the Czechoslovak Academy of Sciences, Prague, the Faculty of Mathematics and Physics of Charles University, Prague, and the Faculty of Natural Sciences of Palacký University, Olomouc, in co-operation with other institutions.

Principal areas of interest include:

- analysis and complexity of algorithms
- automata and formal languages
- theory of programming
- semantics of programming languages
- theory of data structures
- theoretical aspects of operating systems.

This is not intended to be an exhaustive list.

The scientific program will include invited lectures covering areas of current interest and submitted papers describing original research.

Proceedings will be available at the meeting.

Authors are invited to send three copies of a full draft paper in English of approximately 6–10 pages by January 15, 1979. They will be notified of acceptance or rejection by March 1, 1979 and the final text of accepted papers is due by May 15, 1979.
